Thank you for your interest in covering the Pride Festival of Central PA. All press covering Pride Events must be credentialed. Event volunteers, staff and management are instructed not to permit access to the festival grounds or grant interviews to individuals who are not credentialed.

Press credentials are authorized and issued by The Pride Festival of Central PA, the producers of the festival. Credentials will be granted to media personnel on assignment to cover the 2014 Pride Festival for legitimate publications, Internet sites and/or radio and television stations.

Credentialing is now handled prior to the festival. In order to receive media credentials, it is required that you submit your request by completing the attached form. The deadline to submit a request for media credentials is close of business Friday, July 18, 2014. Confirmation of your approved media credential will be sent via email or by phone call.

Media registrants will be required to agree to abide by the photo/audio/TV Policy of the Pride Festival of Central PA, or risk the revocation of the credential privileges.

All Press and Media are to enter the Festival via the South Gate Entrance (off of Vine Street) where Press badges can be obtained. Press Badges are to be worn at all times within the Festival grounds.

Riverfront Park and its premises are leased to the Pride Festival of Central PA and are not considered publicly accessible spaces during this lease period. As such, representatives of the Media are NOT allowed to enter festival without proper credentials from The Pride Festival of Central PA.

Limited media interview opportunities with artists and talent may become available. When interviews are available, it should be noted that first preference for interviews will be given to Pride Festival of Central PA media partners and then evaluated on a case by case basis. A media credential does not guarantee backstage access.

Interviews with Festival Staff and Board members will be scheduled and will occur no earlier than 1:00 PM and no later than 3:30 PM.

Please be mindful that not all participants and festival attendees are "out" about their sexuality. The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania does not currently have a law protecting LGBT individuals from discrimination in housing, in the workplace or in public accommodations based on sexual orientation or gender identity.
